**Subject** Request to Change the Market Price (MP) used in calculating the Exercise Ratio of Warrants

**Re.** Documents on Adjustment of the Exercise Ratio of Warrants (DELTA-W2), dated March 14, 2006

Referring to the above stated document, the Company already adjusted that 1 unit of warrant can be exercised to 1.031 common shares at 1.00 Baht per share, effective from March 7, 2006.

The Company would like to recalculate the exercise ratio based on an adjusted market price (MP) of 20.79 Baht per share from the previous MP of 20.49 Baht per Share. The new MP does not result in a change of the exercise ratio of the warrants. The previous ratio of one unit of warrant can still exercised for 1.031 ordinary shares at 1.00 Baht per share. Detailed calculation is shown below;
